Yellow Archangel
Lamiastrum galeobdolon
is a fast-growing invasive weed that is spreading into a wetland area.



English Holly
Ilex aquifolium
is a garden escapee. Berries spread by birds are poisonous to humans & pets.



Thanks to our hard-working crew, bags of Yellow Archangel were dug up and piles of holly were cut and removed!



Spurge Laurel plants, toxic to people, dogs & cats, was found growing with the holly and removed!
